

Online Athletic Clearance Procedure

1. All Middle and Upper School student-athletes must take the six FHSAA-required courses and submit the Certificate of Completion along with their Physical Forms to be cleared.
FHSAA Required Courses: <https://www.browardschools.com/bcps-departments/athletics/fhsaa-officials/fhsaa-required-courses>
2. If your child did not attend PCA last year, you must fill out and have notarized a GA4 Recruiting Form.
3. Physicals must be on the new EL2 form:
 - Pages 1–2: completed, signed, and dated by the parents and student.
 - Pages 3–4: completed by the doctor with “cleared for participation” checked, doctor’s signature, stamp, and date.
 - Page 5: only if your child is referred to a specialist.
 - All physicals are valid for one year and must be on the new form starting 2023–2024.
 - EL1 EKG/ECG form (required for ALL athletes once during high school)

ONLINE ATHLETIC CLEARANCE FAQ

Multiple Sports

Once you have completed clearance for one sport, you can check off additional sports under the confirmation message for the same year.

Physicals

Download the physical form from the site. Upload the completed form in step #1 and submit a hard copy to the athletic department. Keep a copy for your records.

Why haven't I been cleared?

Your submission will be reviewed by PCA, and you'll receive an email once the student is cleared.

MUST HAVE PROOF OF INSURANCE

Make a copy of your insurance card. Upload it to Athletic Clearance and submit a copy with your paperwork.

If you do not have health insurance for your child you can purchase athletic insurance through School Insurance of Florida
